Meeting of the Administrative Board – September 21, 2026

On **September 21, 2026** the **Administrative Board of Danubius International University** convened for a regular calendar meeting.

During the session, a series of decisions were unanimously approved by the attending members, concerning the university's academic and administrative activities.

We hereby publish the list of topics discussed and approved, while respecting institutional confidentiality:

- Approval of the modification of the Organizational Chart;
- Approval of the appointment of the Vice-Rectors, following the modification of the Organizational Chart;
- Approval of the Report on the Operational Plan of Danubius International University for the academic year 2025–2026;
- Approval of the Operational Plan of Danubius International University for the academic year 2026–2027;
- Approval of the requests for maintaining the status of tenured academic staff after retirement in the academic year 2026–2027 at Danubius International University, in accordance with Article 219 of Law 199/2023 on higher education;
- Approval of the requests submitted by academic staff for employment at DIU in the academic year 2026–2027 as adjunct teaching staff, remunerated on an hourly basis;
- Approval of the requests submitted by DIU tenured academic staff to carry out teaching activities remunerated on an hourly basis at other universities, in the academic year 2026–2027;
- Approval of the proposal to establish new study programmes within the School of Smart Education and Innovative Educators (FESFPI);
- Approval of the opening of competitions in the first semester of the academic year 2026–2027 for the second semester of the academic year 2026–2027, for vacant teaching positions within the Department of Psychology and Social Work, School of Life Sciences and Human Advancement;
- Approval of the opening of competitions in the first semester of the academic year 2026–2027 for vacant teaching positions within the School of Media, Design and Technology.

These decisions reflect the university's commitment to responsible, transparent governance, tailored to the needs of the academic community. In this regard, each adopted resolution contributes to the consolidation of a coherent institutional framework, where administrative and academic processes unfold in a harmonized and predictable manner. We aim for this approach to foster a climate of trust and collaboration, in which every member of the university community feels represented and actively contributes to the institution's development.
