**Internship:**

School of Law, Bachelor or equivalent first cycle: 4 internship hours weekly during the second semester, for the 3rd and 4th year of study;

School of Law, Master or equivalent second cycle: 6 internship hours weekly during the first semester, for the 2nd year of study;

School of Communication and International Relations, Bachelor or equivalent first cycle: the internship is to take place 1 day per week, during the first and second semester of the 2nd year of study;

School of Communication and International Relations, Master or equivalent second cycle: the internship is to take place 1 day per week, during the first and second semester of the 2nd year of study according to the curriculum;

School of Economic Sciences, Bachelor or equivalent first cycle: 6 internship hours weekly during the second semester of the 2nd year of study;

School of Economic Sciences, Master or equivalent second cycle: 6 internship hours weekly during the second semester of the 1st year of study.

School of Applied Sciences, Bachelor or equivalent first cycle: 8 internship hours weekly during the second semester of the 2nd year of study;

**Graduation Exams:**

Graduation exams for the Bachelor or equivalent first cycle are to be organized in 3 sessions during one academic year: winter session (February), summer session (July), Autumn session (September);

Graduation exams for the Master or equivalent second cycle with a duration of 1,5 years of study (3 semesters), School of Law, are to be organized in 2 sessions during one academic year: March-April and September;

Graduation exams for the Master or equivalent second cycle with a duration of 2 years of study (4 semesters), School of Economic Sciences and School of Communication and International Relations are to be organized in 3 sessions during one academic year: winter session (February), summer session (July), Autumn session (September).

\* Examinations for completing studies for graduates who have completed the psycho-pedagogical training program, in order to certify their competencies for the teaching profession - level I, in the regime during the bachelor's studies 3 years, and level II, in the regime during the master's studies - 1, 5 years and 2 years, is organized on a date located after the date of the graduation exams of the programs within the schools and after their graduation, in the same periods - in the summer session (July) and in the autumn session (September).

\*Graduation Paper for Bachelor or equivalent first cycle is to be drafted during 2 weeks (23.05.2022-05.06.2022) in the 8th semester (School of Law), respectively 6th semester for School of Economic Sciences and School of Communication and International Relations.

Graduation Paper for Master or equivalent second cycle is to be drafted during 2 weeks (23.05.2022-05.06.2022), in the 4th semester for School of Economic Sciences and School of Communication and International Relations.

Graduation Paper for Master or equivalent second cycle of the School of Law is to be drafted 2 hours weekly, during the 3rd semester, 2nd year of study.

For students who are also enrolled in the Psychopedagogical Training Program for certification for the teaching profession level I, during undergraduate studies and level II, during master's degree studies, teaching activities comply with this structure of the academic year.

Students who have credited exams (not passed) from previous years and have paid the credit fees, can take the exams in the exam sessions of the academic year, together with a group of the year that has a planned exam in those subjects.

Students who have paid the credit fee can also take the exams in the resits sessions.

According to the legislation in force, the public holidays (days off) are as follows: November 30, 2021; 1, 25 and 26 December 2021; 1, 2 and 24 January 2022; 22, 24 and 25 April 2022; May 1, 2022; 1, 12 and 13 June 2022; August 15, 2022.
